Wooly Riding / Steer Riding Finals are all three (3) nights at the Gallup Lions Club Rodeo @ Red Rock Park on June 15, 16, & 17, 2017.

Young Guns Steering Riding Series entry fee is \$50.00 (Age 8-12, proof of age required)

- April 8, 2017 – Steering Riding 1st event
- April 15, 2017 – Steer Riding 2nd event
- April 22, 2017 – Steer Riding 3rd event

Birth Certificates/ Verification of DOB are required to compete!

Event Rules: Young Guns Steer Riding must be 12 or under as of April 8, 2017.

If the contestant is 12 as of 4/8/17 and turns 13 during the season, he/she will be eligible to compete for the remainder of the season.

The winner on each date will automatically qualify for a spot in the ride-off at the Gallup Lions Club Rodeo on Saturday night.

Helmets and vest are required!

Spurs are allowed

Ride will ride with one hand.

Rider must ride for 6 seconds to qualify.

Re-rides will only be given if the steer falls to the ground and remains down; by no fault of the rider.

Riders out of position that cause the steer to fall will not be granted a re-ride.

Judges will have the final determination for a re-ride.

Wooly Riding Competition is \$30.00 (Age 7 & under, proof of age required)

- May 6, 2017 – Wooly Riding 1st Event
- May 13, 2017 – Wooly Riding 2nd Event
- May 20, 2017 – Wooly Riding 3rd Event

Birth Certificates are required to compete!

Event Rules: WRC participant must be 7 years or younger as of 5/6/2017.

If contestant is 7 as of 5/6/2017 and turns 8 during the season, they are eligible to compete in all of the series events.

The winner on each date will automatically qualify for a spot in the ride-off at the Gallup Lions Club Rodeo on Saturday night.

Helmets and vest are required!

Absolutely No Spurs allowed.

Any method of hanging on is allowed.

Rider must ride for 6 seconds to qualify

Re-rides will only be given if the sheep falls to the ground and remains down; by no fault of the rider.

Riders out of position that cause the sheep to fall will not be granted a re-ride.

Judges will have the final determination for a re-ride.
